With more than 80 electronic tracking and temperature-monitoring devices approved for all United aircraft, enjoy additional shipment visibility and security.

Booking and acceptance

From outside of the U.S. and Canada, contact your local United Cargo sales professional or visit unitedcargo.com. We may accept shipments requiring dangerous goods, such as dry ice, with some exceptions. Please note special rules and regulations apply to these shipments. We're unable to re-route, change the destination, or terminate a QuickPak shipment once it's been accepted and is in transit. Ask your local United Cargo sales professional for more information.

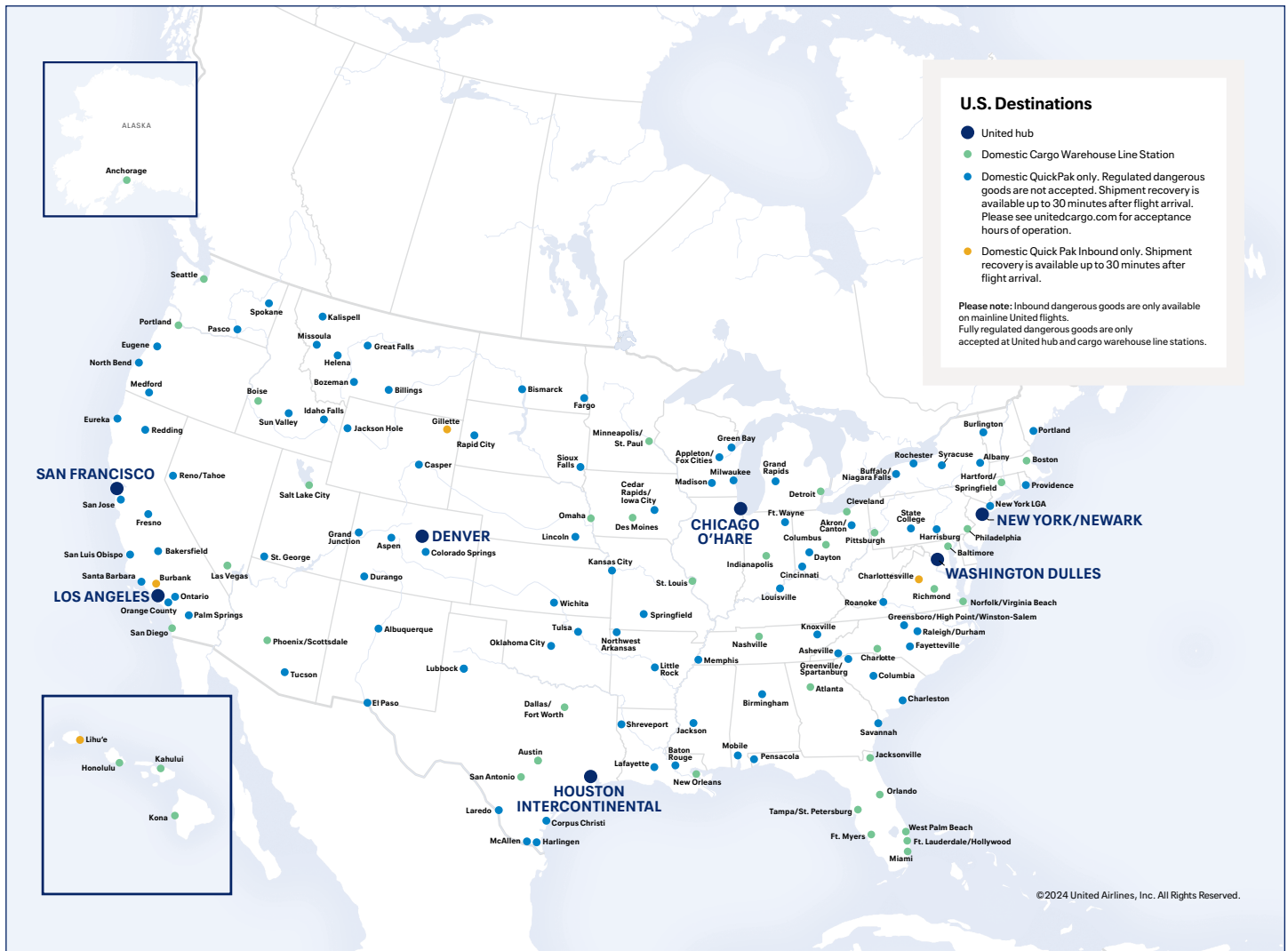

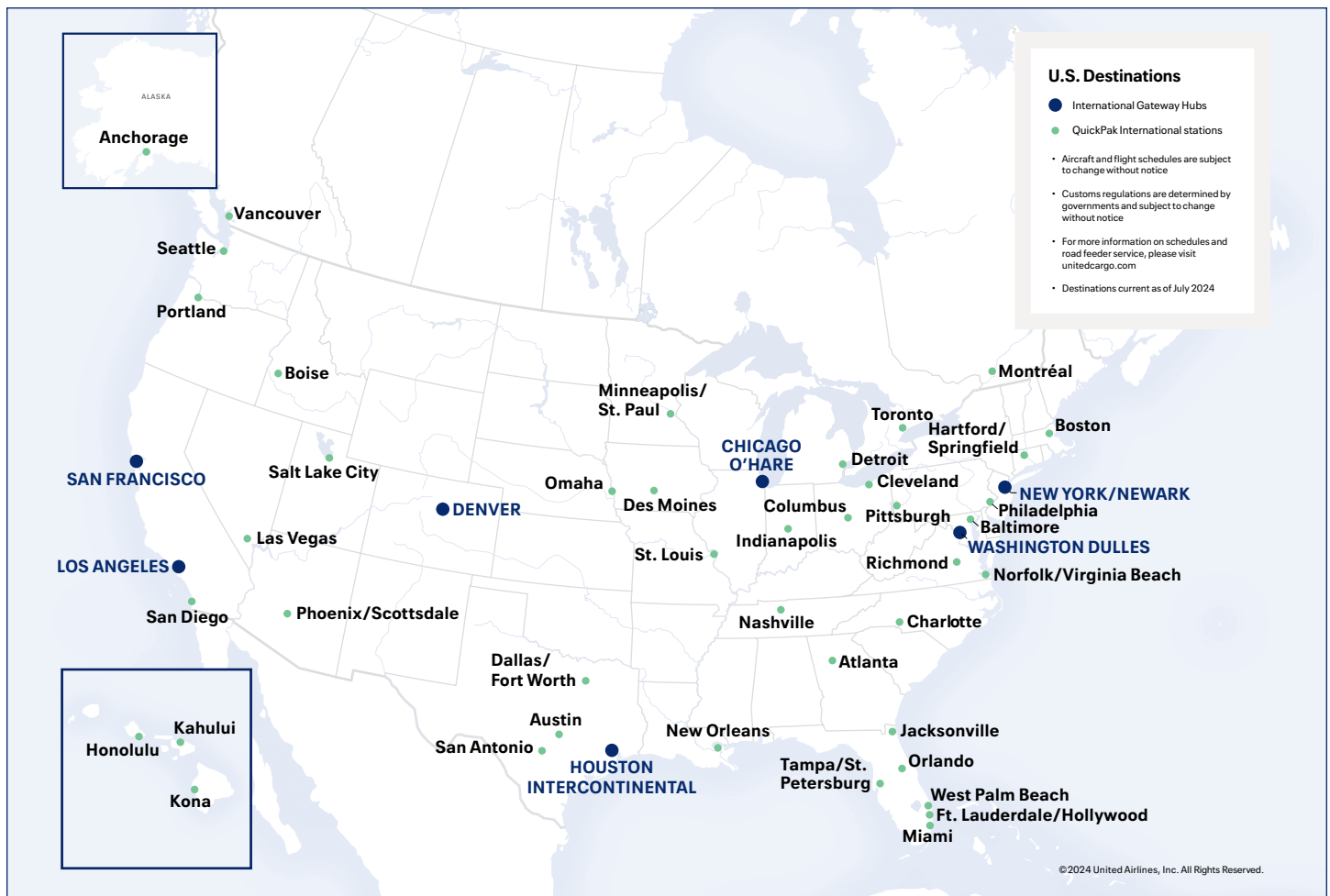
